CONDITIONALATIES REGARDING CLASSIFICATION AND NOTIFICATION OF SUBSTANCES

- 1- Manufacturing of substances on their own or in a mixture one tonne or more per producer or importer per year,
- 2- Importing of substances on their own or in a mixture one tonne or more per producer or importer per year,
- 3- Substance is present in articles in quantities totalling over one tonne per producer or importer per year and it is intended to be released,
- 4- Substance is present in polymers in quantities totalling over one tonne per producer or importer per year provided that those polymer consists of 2 % weight by weight (w/w) or more of such monomer substance(s) or other substance(s) in the form of monomeric units and chemically bound substance(s) and the total quantity of such monomer substance(s) or other substance(s) makes up one tonne or more per year.
- 5- Substances which are present in articles in quantities totalling over one tonne per producer or importer per year and present a concentration above 0,1 % weight by weight (w/w) in those articles and which:
- a) are classified as carcinogenic, mutagenic or toxic to reproduction, category 1A,1B or category 2,or
- b) show persistent, bioaccumulative and toxic (PBT) properties, or
- c) very persistent and very bioaccumulative (vPvB) properties, or
- ç) substances such as those having endocrine disrupting properties or those having persistent, bioaccumulative and toxic properties or very persistent and very bioaccumulative properties, which do not fulfil the criteria of points (b) or (c) for which there is scientific evidence of probable serious effects to human health or the environment which give rise to an equivalent level of concern to those of other substances listed in points (a) to (c).
